Applications are invited for the following position:

LECTURER, DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL STUDIES - AC/2/56/21 - (CAVS) - 3 POSTS

Applicants are required to have an earned PhD in Clinical Studies or Veterinary Clinical Studies disciplines or in Wildlife Ecology and Conservation Science from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate OR a Masters degree qualification (plus a PhD registration) in the named specialty areas from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate (in special cases). They must also have a minimum of three (3) years teaching and research experience at university level or in research or in industry in the relevant area. The applicant must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals, two (2) scholarly book chapters OR; two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occassional papers OR; two (2) published teaching/lecture modules. Applicants must demonstrate evidence of community service. Those in Veterinary Clinical fields must be registered with Kenya Veterinary Board (KVB) while those in other fields must be registered with the relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach, examine, mentor and supervise both undergraduate and postgraduate students. He/she will also be expected to undertake further research, carry out clinical duties including odd hours, weekends and public holidays, as well as participate in assigned Departmental activities.
