Applicants must be holders of a Master's degree in Biotechnology, Medical Laboratory Technology, Biological Sciences or related field from a recognized institution plus three (3) years' experience as a Chief Technologist Grade 12 in a busy Human Anatomy teaching/research laboratory. They must have experience working in Gross Anatomy, Microscopic Anatomy and Developmental Anatomy laboratories as well as the Mortuary. Participation in publication/academic writing will be an added advantage.
