The Centre for Healthcare Quality and Innovation (CHQI), based at the Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Nairobi, seeks to recruit two (2) Public Health Evaluation Associates on a three-month temporary basis in Nairobi, reporting to the Principal Investigator.

Job Purpose:

Participate in the design, planning, implementation, and evaluation of public health programmes

Duties and Responsibilities:

- a) Program design, development, planning and evaluation;
- b) Literature survey and synthesis;
- c) Study protocol development, planning and implementation;
- d) Data collection, analysis, and report writing;
